1. Introduction

This privacy policy has been prepared to inform you about the practices of MEDonline regarding the collection, use and disclosure of personal data (as described below) via https://aCSCC.eu/ (the 'site') in its capacity as data controller.

By "personal data" we mean all information related to an identified or identifiable natural person, as further defined in the general regulation data protection (EU) 2016/679.

By "data controller" we mean the person, company or other body that, alone or together with others, determines the purpose and means of personal **data** processing, as further specified defined the general data protection regulation (EU) 2016/679. 2. Processing of access data

- E-mail address
- Account details (Username and password)
- Specialty and possibly registration number

We process your personal data to ensure that you can also use it of the protected areas for which you must log in. The legal basis for this Data processing is largely the implementation of an (account) agreement with you.

In addition, a legal basis is our legitimate interest in the careful management of accounts and accounts

record keeping. The accreditation points you have obtained are also passed on with your BIG number.

3. Processing of contact details

4. Other data processing

This site also processes personal information sent by your own browser, such as your

5. Cookies

6. Retention of personal data

7. Your rights

In accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation, you have the following rights:
